Minutes of the meeting for March 26, 2024 Hybrid Meeting hosted by Miss Utility in Hanover, MD Prepared by Susan Sullivan

CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Chairman Kevin Woolbright called the regular monthly meeting to order at 9:32 AM. There were thirty-two (32) attendees onsite and twelve (12) virtual attendees.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion to approve the February 27, 2024, minutes was made by Michael Jewell (Columbia Gas) and seconded by Shelly Masone (Ecotech). The motion carried by approval.

OPEN DISCUSSION

Jennifer Arroyo (Miss Utility) stated that after a recent meeting with members of the Miss Utility Board of Directors, it was decided that ITICnxt's Other Tool would continue functioning 'as is' with further dialog to take place during the next MD/DC BOD Meeting in April.

George Daffan (Utiliquest) requested that users continue to submit accurate, clear, and concise and easy to understand marking instructions in addition to any autofill information that may be included in the Extent of Work field. For example, instructions that simply read: MARK REAR OF PROPERTY, is preferred over, or in addition to, latitude/longitude points that may be included as part of autofill instructions.

Randy Carey (NPL) thanked those who have offered condolences as he mourns the loss of his daughter who passed earlier this year. His new granddaughter is doing well, and he looks forward to seeing everyone in May.

Shelly Welling (Gray N Son) reminded attendees of the importance of letting ticket processors know that they can change the EOW verbiage in order to provide clear and concise marking instructions. Susan Sullivan (Miss Utility) then added that Miss Utility offers free monthly ITIC training where this and other valuable ticketing information is shared.

Michael Jewell (Columbia Gas) asked if USIC representatives were in attendance. There were none. Kevin Woolbright (DPC Chairman) to provide contact information and to continue to ask for USIC's support and participation during the DPC meetings.

Lenny Corbin (Gray N Son) thanked Marc Haines (BGE) and Susan Sullivan for supporting their 2024 annual trainings. He encouraged others to offer training to **all** employees and not just the excavators, as all company members can learn information that could potentially be lifesaving.

Mary Hill (Ferguson) educated attendees about props and covers that are available to property owners that are designed to cover or hide unsightly above ground utility boxes, peds, transformers, etc. These covers can make 'clear evidence' very difficult to see and offered this information as an awareness to those who are responsible for working around or referencing above ground facilities.

Referring back to the Other Tool, Erik Phillips (Utiliquest) asked about restricting its use. Jennifer Arroyo explained that the tool cannot be restricted as it needs to be available to all users in instances where streets, parcels, or boundaries have not yet been added to necessary mapping platforms in which case the Other Tool must be used. He then asked about mandating ITIC training to which Jennifer explained that although monthly training is offered to users on a regular basis, training for standard ticketing is not nor should it be mandatory.

Shelly Welling (Ecotech) suggested that a pop-up or note be added to all Code 10's providing information on free ITIC Training. Susan explained that ITIC Resource and Training information is provided on all ITIC Error emails that are sent out via Miss Utility.

GUEST SPEAKER: Susan Sullivan | Miss Utility

After opening Miss Utility's Sandbox platform (Try the Demo at http://missutility.tryitic.com/) Susan gave a high-level ticket processing overview with a focus on the following:

- During step 1, providing an address engages Google Maps to get you to the given map location which is marked with a green arrow. This address does not necessarily get populated in the address ticket field as it's the placement/clicking of the polygon that auto-fills the address, street, nearest intersecting street, and city (all of which can be edited during step 2). The county is also automatically filled in but cannot be edited.
- Ticket processor should select the drawing tool that best captures the entire dig site. The Other Tool should only be used if the Property, Street, Radius or Route Tool cannot be used to accurately capture the dig site. The polygon is used for utility member notification and should not be referenced in the Extent of Work field.
- During step 2, all auto-filled ticket fields, except the county, can be edited, deleted, or added to in order to provide the most accurate information possible. This may include editing an address, city, marking instructions and/or driving directions.
- After ticket submission and release to affected utility owner members, a copy of the ticket is sent to the ticket processor's email for one final confirmation. If errors are found, please submit corrections, or cancel and resubmit the ticket with corrections made.
